

Greenmont Walk Do's and Don'ts:



Do's:

- Uphold the Association CCRs and Architectural Design Standards
- Pick up after your dog while walking him/her through the neighborhood
- Talk to your neighbors before starting a project that effects the outside appearance of your home
- Submit work approval requests at least two weeks before starting your project
- Keep lawns mowed and well-trimmed
- Volunteer to help in the neighborhood
- Pay Association annual dues on time
- Notify the Association if you have a change of address or ownership
- Keep trash containers out of view from the street and from your neighbors
- Smile, wave, and get to know your neighbors

Don'ts:

- Do not park automobiles in cul-de-sacs overnight
- Do not leave trash cans out more than 24 hours before or after the pickup schedule
- Do not allow bushes and trees to obstruct the sidewalks
- Do not place signs of any kind in the center island at the front entrance
- Do not exceed the speed limit (25 MPH) in the neighborhood
- Do not submit complaints without a fully completed complaint form
- Do not disturb the peace at odd hours (barking dogs, lawn/power equipment, loud music, etc.)
- Do not park trailers, boats, dilapidated vehicles, etc. in driveways or on the street
- Do not leave garage doors open all day
- Do not leave vehicles unlocked overnight
